Sleeping accommodations are dormitory style in our beautiful barrier free residential retreat. Bathrooms/showers are beautifully designed and fully equipped.

Who Can Attend?

Families with an individual who has Spina Bifida or any individual aged 21 and over who has Spina Bifida is invited. You will be responsible for all of your own personal care needs. We will do our best to accommodate any special dietary needs (e.g. gluten free or pureed food). Please note these on your registration form. Individuals/families will be expected to participate in provided activities.

No medical personal will be available in camp, but local hospitals and emergency medical
